*K* is for Kindness where we begin and we end.



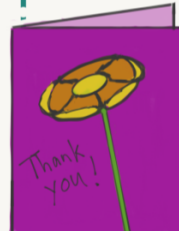

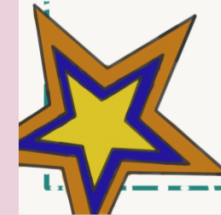

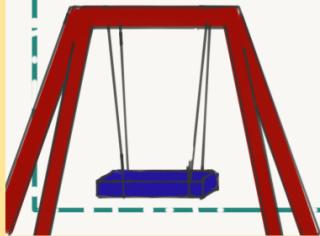
